

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
PAID ON-CALL FIREFIGHTER/EMT or PARAMEDIC REQUIREMENTS
2010 –2012 ELIGIBILITY LIST**

1. Citizenship of the United States must be maintained as a condition of employment. Applicant must submit birth certificate or naturalization papers.
2. Residency is required within one (1) mile of the municipal boundaries of Washington Township.
3. Not less than eighteen (18) years of age on the date of application.
4. Applicant must be the holder of a valid Michigan driver's (or chauffeur's) license (or an equivalent from another state) and have a good driving record in accordance with, but not limited to the following standards:
 - a. No conviction for alcohol –related driving offenses.
 - b. No conviction for reckless driving.
 - c. No more than four (4) points on driving record at time of submission of this application.
 - d. No loss of driving privileges through suspension or revocation within the last five (5) years.
5. Must not have been convicted of a violation of criminal law. (Criminal law generally includes traffic law, conservation law, and liquor law.) In general, conviction for a violation of criminal law is automatic disqualification. Applicants will not be automatically disqualified for a prior conviction for a misdemeanor punishable by 90 days in jail or less.
6. Capable of performing the essential job functions of firefighter as set forth in Fire Department Rules and Regulations.
7. Educational minimum of a high school diploma or GED Certificate.
8. Must possess a State of Michigan Firefighter II Certificate at deadline for application and at time of hire. Applicant must submit copy of current certificate by deadline for application and at time of hire.
9. Must possess a State of Michigan EMT license at deadline for application and at time of hire. Applicant must submit proof of license by deadline and at time of hire.
10. Must read, understand and comply with the Washington Township F.D. "Professional Appearances/Grooming Standards". Applicant must sign acknowledgement form at time of written exam.

SELECTION PROCESS

A written examination **will be given on Thursday, March 4, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. at the Washington Township Hall, 57900 Van Dyke, Washington Township, MI 48094.** The examination will only be given to those applicants who successfully meet the minimum requirements and have submitted the proper proof of entry-level criteria. (Test costs paid by applicant)

Candidates passing the written examination will be scheduled for the oral board interview examination. Applicant must score 75% or better to pass the oral examination. A two-year eligibility list will then be formulated based on the average of the applicants' written and oral scores (40% Written /60% Oral).

Candidates must successfully pass the character background check, psychological examination, drug test and physical examination administered by or directed by Washington Township.

Candidates must have CPAT (Candidate Physical Agility Test) certification at time of hire (or current CPAT less than year prior to application deadline date).

ALL ENTRY LEVEL CRITERIA MUST BE MET, AND PROOF, INCLUDING COPIES OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE, HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED CERTIFICATE, FIREFIGHTER II CERTIFICATE, EMT LICENSE AND ACLS CERTIFICATE MUST BE SUBMITTED BY APPLICATION DEADLINE OF FEBRUARY 26, 2010.
