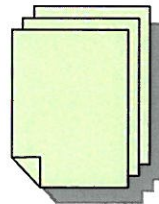

- Computer (including monitor, keyboard, mouse, hard drive, and laptops) **Note: Hard drives will be destroyed off site along with all other material. You may choose to remove your hard drive and destroy it yourself.**
- Copy machine Microwave

- TV (\$10 fee— no size restriction)
- VCR
- Telephone (including cell phones and cordless phones)
- Radio/Stereo (including cassette players and CD players)
