

15 Mile Interceptor Collapse Update

Feb. 8, 2017

What's new:

- Despite day-long rains on Tuesday, Feb. 7, no sewer discharges were necessary into Macomb County waterways
- The Macomb County Board of Commissioners will meet on Thursday, Feb. 9, to discuss establishing a \$20 million line of credit to finance to be in place until the Office of Public Works sells bonds to pay for the ongoing work at the collapsed sewer interceptor

Traffic:

- The intersection of Utica Road and 15 Mile Road will be closed in all directions 9 p.m. Friday, Feb. 10, until 5 a.m. Monday, Feb. 13.

Ongoing:

- Work continues from both the east and the west on the long-term bypass pipes that will carry all sewage flow around the collapsed interceptor. That work continues to have a targeted completion date of the first week of March.
