STORM OR SANITARY SEWER BACK-UP

Notice of Claim

Under the guidelines of Public Act 222, any resident or business owner having experienced an overflow or backup of a sewage disposal system or storm water system, please contact the Washington Township Sewer & Water Department immediately. **You must file a written claim with Washington Township within 45 days after the overflow or back up is discovered. Failure to provide the required notice will prevent recovery of damages.**
